The Lyric winter season offers something for L everyone with a packed line up of world class talent.

First up in the 2014 winter season, The Academy Orchestra presents Francesco Attesti (Sunday, January 5th at 7pm), internationally acclaimed pianist. Attesti, one of the leading interpreters of the romantic and early 20th century repertoire, has graced the stages of some of the most prestigious concert halls, including the Philharmonic Hall of Saint Petersburg, Moscow Tchaikovsky Conservatory, and the Mozarteum of Salzburg. The young pianist gave his first concert at age 11, playing a transcription of *Toccata and Fugue in D Minor* by J.S. Bach. He performs regularly in prestigious concert halls including the Philharmonia Hall of St. Petersburg, Russia, the Tchaikovsky Conservatory of Moscow, Conservatorio Giuseppe Verdi in Milan, Italy, and at universities in the U.S. such as Columbia University in New York and the University of Denver. In addition, Attesti has recorded several CDs with various classical music labels such as Agora, and Max Research. His most recent recording was "Feeling Chopin" with the Drycastle label. Now, Francesco comes to The Lyric for another celebrated performance with the Academy Orchestra.

With over three million books in print, Pogue is also one of the world's best-selling "how-to" authors.

Batten down the hatches! Gaelic Storm (Wednesday, January 22nd at 7pm) is blowing through The Lyric with their blend of animated instrumentals, lyrical honesty, and raw Celtic spirit. The crowd pleasing pop-folk band has attracted a throng of devoted fans after their appearance in the 1997 blockbuster Titanic. With a high-energy group like Gaelic Storm, there's nothing like experiencing them live!

In 1996, Patrick Murphy, Steve Wehmeyer, Steve Twigger, and Brian Walsh got together at O'Brien's Irish Pub and Restaurant in Santa Monica, California, experimenting with a unique blend of Scottish, Irish, and pop music. With the overwhelming support of the local audience, the musicians decided to form a band and Gaelic Storm was born. After only a short time performing at a number of pubs in the area, the group received the attention of James Cameron, who asked them to play the role of the band in the ship steerage party scene. This big break launched Gaelic Storm into international focus and gained the group a considerable number of followers. Today, the Irish-bred band plays over 125 dates every year, performing nationally and

internationally from the United Kingdom to Japan.

With their signature acoustic production, Gaelic Storm blends indie-folk and world grooves with Celtic tradition to bring you twelve tales of plight and plunder, whiskeydrenched pirates, flying cannon balls and the ladies of ill repute. Ready your sea legs, you'll need them for the boathouse!

Conjuring up the sounds of yesteryear is The Glenn Miller **Orchestra** (Thursday, January 23rd

at 6pm & 8:30pm), the most popular and sought after big band in the world today. The Glenn Miller Orchestra celebrates over 50 years of bringing big band into the spotlight, recreating the legendary ensemble of the man who defined swing. With all the flair expected from a 1940s brass band, the Glenn Miller Orchestra performs classics from way back when, including "Chatanooga Choo Choo," "Moonlight Serenade," and more.

Just as the original Glenn Miller Orchestra celebrated wide acclaim, performing in dance halls, studio sets, and theaters across the United States, the new Glenn Miller Orchestra has become one of most highly successful big bands in the nation, performing an average of 300 live dates a year. The Glenn Miller Orchestra proves that brass is alive and well. The orchestra covers not only Glenn Miller's own classic pieces, but a number of other hit songs as well, including "Swing Low Sweet Chariot," "Someone To Watch Over Me," and "Danny Boy." Relive the glory days of swing this January at The Lyric.

Jazzing it up next is the **John** Pizzarelli Quartet (Saturday, January 25th at 6pm & 8:30pm). Pizzarelli, the world-renowned jazz guitarist and singer, has been called "Hip with a wink"

by Town & Country and "the genial genius of the guitar" by Toronto Star. Over his career, John Pizzarelli has revitalized jazz, bringing a refreshing, modern twist to the genre while staying true to its roots. Called "madly creative" by the L.A. Times, the guitarist and singer is not afraid to blend styles, mixing pop and Latin styles with a jazzy flair, making him one of the most interesting contemporary artists today. Since his success with the Boston Pops, John Pizzarelli has skyrocketed into fame, hailed for his finely crafted performances and memorable albums.

Despite his range of influences, John Pizzarelli names Nat King Cole as his greatest hero, even dedicating two of his albums to the legendary musician. However, that hasn't stopped the contemporary jazz star from having fun with the genre of jazz. In 2004, Pizzarelli produced a CD entitled Bossa Nova featuring the clever and inspired blending of Brazilian musical stylings and traditional jazz. His latest album, Double *Exposure*, is a celebration of pop music, reinvigorated with a splash of jazz.

Returning for another raucous night of comedy is **Capitol Steps**

(Monday, January 27th at 6pm & 8:30pm). What was originally a small group of Senate staffers with a sense of humor became the rip-roaring comedy sensation that it is today. Capitol Steps makes even the most boring news stories hilarious. Drawing from headlines and insider information, the topical comedy show leaves no joke behind. Featured on national television from NBC to PBS, Capitol Steps has swept the nation with its witty quips and absurd skits.

NOVEMBER 29, 1930 Newly equipped with RCA Photophone sound picture machines, The Lyric Theatre opened with railroad thriller "Danger Lights' (picture with sound)

If blues is your thing, you must see An Acoustic Evening with Keb' Mo'

(Tuesday, January 28th at 6pm & 8:30pm). Join singersongwriter, guitarist and 3-time Grammy winner Keb' Mo' in an intimate acoustic performance. His music in a living link to the seminal Delta blues that traveled up the Mississippi River and across the expanse of America informing all of its musical roots — before evolving into a universally celebrated art form.

His distinctive sound embraces multiple eras and genres, including pop, soul, folk and jazz as well as the singer-songwriter movement. For Keb' Mo', the common bond between these influences is the underlying storytelling ethic, the power of song to convey human experience and emotional weight. Keb' Mo' promises to get down with The Lyric this January with his style of Delta Blues as a modern take on a classic music style. The Reflection is the first new studio album by Keb' Mo' since Suitcase in 2006 earned a sixth Grammy nomination. These twelve songs are the product of an important period

of personal and professional growth for the artist formerly known as Kevin Moore. In that time, he started a new family, moved from Los Angeles to Nashville, built a state–of–the–art

home studio, and founded his own label, Yolabelle International, distributed by Ryko and the Warner Music Group. But The Reflection is not, in essence, a blues album. In sound and spirit, it's closer to


the work of African-American "folk soul" singer/songwriters like Bill Withers, Bobby Womack, and Terry Callier.

The Lyric is thrilled to welcome back Mel Tillis (Friday, January 31st at 6pm & 8:30pm), country music legend and Hall of Fame inductee. Mel Tillis is a songwriting legend with over 60 albums under his belt. Performing with his band, The Statesiders, Tillis has earned his place among the country veterans, coining 36 top ten singles over his 50 year career, including "Ruby, Don't Take Your Love to Town" and "Good Woman Blues." The songwriter of choice for music stars, including George Strait and Kenny Rogers, Mel Tillis is a force still to be reckoned with.

In total, Mel has recorded over 1,000 songs, 600 of which have been recorded by major country music and pop music artists. Not only a talented songwriter, Mel Tillis has recorded over 60 albums, containing nine #1 hits, including "Coca Cola Cowboy" and "Southern Rain."
